# Steps for Taking the CLEP Exam at Grayson County College

- ◆ Students who believe they possess the knowledge and skills essential in certain courses or programs offered by GCC may challenge these by credit by examination. You are eligible to take a CLEP exam if you have never been enrolled in the course.
- ◆ Complete the CLEP Registration form (available in the Testing Center).
- ◆ Bring the following to the Testing Center to order your tests:
  - Completed CLEP Registration form
  - Test fees per exam:
    - \* \$120 money order payable to CLEP (Additional \$10 for Freshman College Composition Essay)
    - \* \$15 check, money order, or cash payable to GCC (Additional \$10 for Freshman College Composition Essay)
- ◆ When tests have arrived from CLEP, Testing Center personnel will schedule an appointment for your CLEP test and give you an admission ticket. Only two (2) exams may be taken on a given test date.
- ◆ Arrive promptly on the assigned test date. Bring your admission ticket and two forms of identification including one government-issued photo ID. Non-programming, non-graphing calculators are permitted only for accounting, chemistry, algebra, and calculus exams. Plan 90 minutes testing time for each subject exam.
- ◆ Test materials will be mailed to CLEP for scoring.

- ◆ Upon receipt of scores from CLEP, Testing Center personnel will notify you of credit earned and indicate when you should return to pick up your credit award application.
- ◆ Complete the process by taking the credit award form and CLEP score report to the Registrar's Office to have the credit added to your transcript.
- ◆ Complete all steps as soon as possible but no later than one year after testing.
