

## COMPASS Placement Test

The COMPASS Placement Test is one of the four approved placement tests used to demonstrate college readiness for Texas Success Initiative (TSI) purposes. COMPASS is a computer-adaptive test which is used by GCC for last minute testing situations (immediately prior to a semester). Scores on the Reading and Mathematics sections will be available immediately after testing; scores on the Writing section are usually available within two business days. Test fee is \$40, payable by exact cash, money order, or check with driver's license number on it. Photo ID is required. Students must wait 30 days before retesting on COMPASS.

Because seating is limited for the COMPASS Placement Test, we do not recommend that students wait to take this test at the last minute. Instead, please register to take the THEA Quick Test on one of the many available test dates.
