

COMPASS Placement Test

Students who need the basic skills assessment in Reading, Mathematics, and Writing for Spring 2010 classes may take the COMPASS Placement Test.

COMPASS may be taken by first-time testers as well as retesters. Students will answer multiple-choice questions in Reading, Mathematics, and Writing; they will also be required to write an essay. The multiple-choice section is untimed; average time is two hours. The essay section is timed; students are allowed 75 minutes to complete the essay. We are estimating that the total time for the COMPASS Placement Test will be about three hours.

1. Your Social Security number
2. Which sections of the test you need to take. Check with GCC counselor before test date if you need assistance.

SCORES: Most students will receive a complete score report soon after testing.
