All required Uniform and Materials items must be purchased and shown to the Director of TRPA before the first day of class. A specific deadline to show items will be provided. The Equipment list must be shown by the eight week of class. It is the responsibility of each individual student to obtain the necessary items timely.

NOTE: Blackhawk 5.11 brand of the same style and color may be substituted for the above items.

The below listed items may be purchased from a variety of internet sites or local clothing suppliers. No logos or writing of any kind will be visible on any of these items, except the shoes/boots may have whatever manufacturer's marks are usual in their business.

Uniform shoes or boots – black only

Athletic shoes - black or white

Black socks - to be worn with the academy uniform

Black or white athletic socks (color to match athletic shoe color)

Navy Blue Tee shirt (for PT)

Navy Blue gym short (no below knee or baggy or other odd style)

Below items are not required. They are optional for cooler weather.

Navy Blue sweat pant

Navy Blue sweat shirt (with or without hood, zippered or pullover)

Coat or jacket is not required; item is optional for cooler weather; must match TruSpec or Blackhawk police or military style; black or Navy blue color.

Hat is not required; optional if desired; must match coat specifications above.

1 pair of quality hearing protectors (" earmuffs", not ear plugs)

1 pair of protective eye glasses for firearms training (prescription lens will work)

1000 rounds of practice handgun ammunition for the caliber handgun you will bring.

9mm Para/NATO/Luger, 115 or 124 grain, Full Metal Jacket, factory ammunition, if student plans to use one of the academy handguns.

5 rounds of 12 gauge 00 buck shot

5 rounds of 12 gauge rifle slugs

25 rounds of 12 gauge field loads (7-1/2 or 8 shot)

All shotgun ammunition is to be of a "low recoil", "reduced recoil", or "tactical" type, and standard 2-3/4" length; not 3"; not "magnum". All students use the academy shotgun.

If students bring their own handgun it must be a semiautomatic, currently approved for police patrol duty use, of high quality, and in excellent condition. Note the required holster above. Students must have sufficient magazines to load fifty rounds of ammunition with no more than five loose rounds left over. Magazines are provided for the academy's guns.
