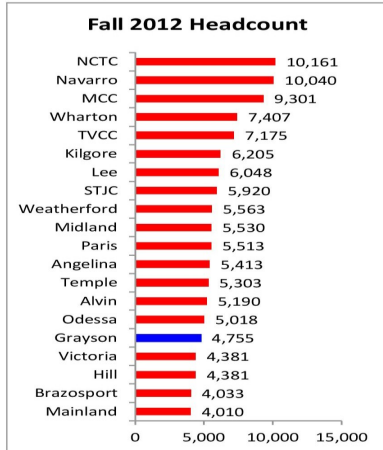

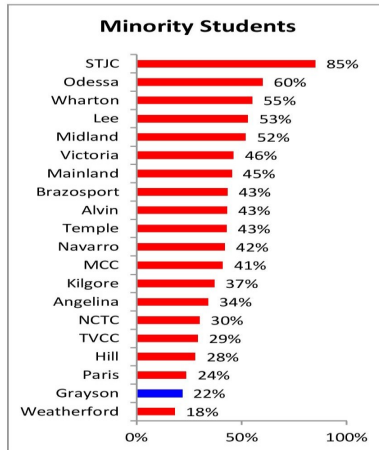

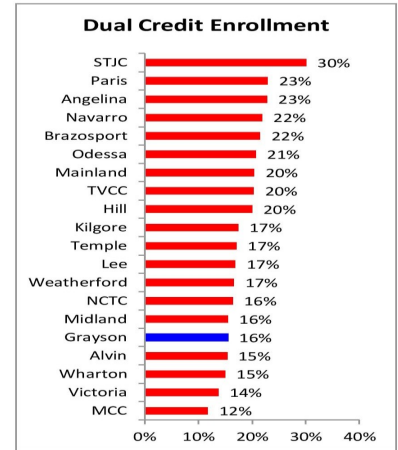

The institutional fall unduplicated headcount enrollment (Fall 2012)

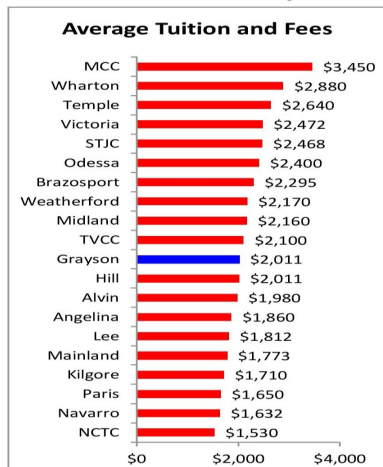


African-American, Hispanic, Asian, and International students (Fall 2012)

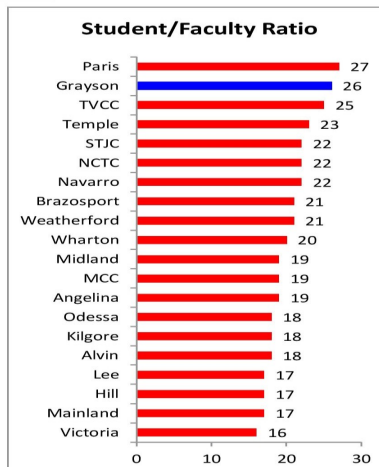


Dual Credit enrollment as a percentage of total enrollment (Fall 2012)

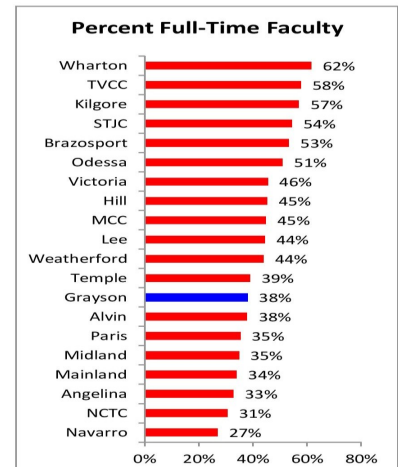

The cost of tuition and mandatory fees charged to a student taking 30 semester credit hours (FY2013)

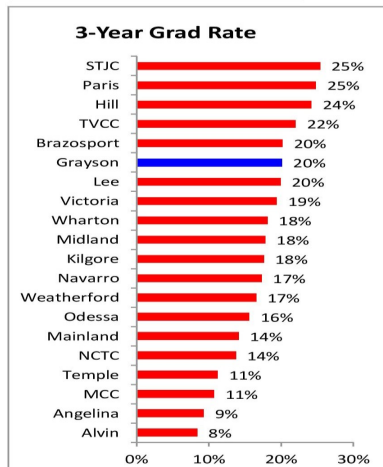


Number of full-time student equivalents per one full-time equivalent teaching faculty (Fall 2011)

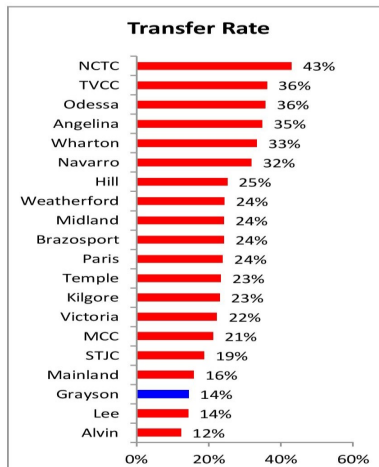


Percentage of full-time (teaching 80 percent or more) faculty members (Fall 2011)

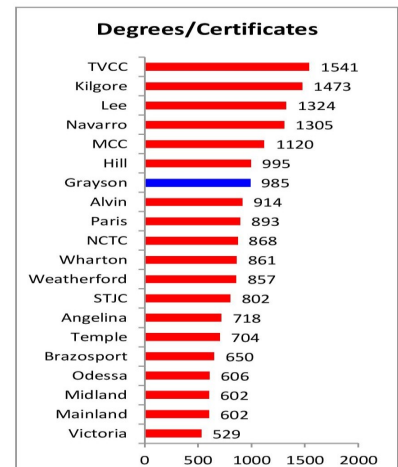
