Ray Family Innovative Learning Grant

The endowed *Ray Family Innovative Learning Grant*, established through the Grayson College Foundation in March 2014, is to be awarded annual to a Grayson College colleague who completes a grant request which is approved by his or her academic dean (or vice president), with an idea that will provide resources or bring about new and creative teaching practices and/or learning concepts which will improve student success.

The grant proposal should address a new project, as opposed to one already accomplished or under way, unless the resource being requested is a new enhancement. This fund will generate annual awards – or an approved grant may be accrued over a period of time – for a Grayson College colleague who aspires to be creative in his or her respective field.

Applicants must complete and submit the Grayson College Foundation Innovative Learning Grant Application, have their idea approved and signed by their dean (or vice president), and submit the application to the Grayson College Foundation for committee approval. More than one applicant may apply each year, and awards will be made to the extent that funds are available. Each recipient must provide a report describing how their award funds were used and the result achieved, as well as an accounting for the total grant funds, within one year of receipt of the funds. If no grant requests are received or paid during any calendar year, the accrued funds will remain in the endowment for future grant recipients. The annual grant recipient will be known in Grayson College publications as the *Ray Family Innovative Learning Grant*.
