Step 3: If you wish to test on the same day as College 101 follow the directions below.

The THEA Quick Test can be completed on the same day as College 101. The test is a version of the THEA (Texas Higher Education Assessment) that GCC can schedule on our campus to better fit our students' testing needs. It is the same length as the regular THEA and GCC will receive the scores in about one week. Pre-registration is required. Reservations may be made starting one month before the test date.

HOW TO RESERVE A SEAT FOR THE TEST

Bring registration/administration fee of \$10.00 exact cash, check with driver's license number on it or money order (payable to GCC) to the Testing Center on the campus where you wish to test. On your reserved test date, you will need to bring an additional \$29.00 test fee for National Evaluation Systems.
