

# Notice Of Tax Revenue Increase

The Grayson County College Board of Trustees conducted public hearings on August 19 and August 25 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Grayson County College District from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 34.12 percent.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.139739 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$8,277,370.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of .184356 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$11,101,609.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of .184356 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$11,419,425.

The Grayson County College Board of Trustees is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 2, 2008 in the GCC Administrative Services Building Board Room, Main Campus, 6101 Grayson Drive, Denison, Texas 75020 at 8:00 a.m.
