

College Success Council Function and Purpose

- Identify existing values, assumptions, structures and systems at the college that nurture and impede student success (ATD)
- Consider leverage points to improve student outcomes, lead a process for setting institutional priorities, goals and strategies (ATD)
- Perform an inventory of policy and practice barriers that inhibit student success (ATD)
- Engage students, faculty, community members and others in dialogue about the analysis and proposed goals and strategies (ATD)
- Ensure that strategies are aligned with the college budget, strategic plan, and other major initiatives in order to promote sustainability (ATD)
- Provide leadership to spread a culture of inquiry, reflection, and commitment to student success throughout the college (ATD)
- Organized around the five strategic Goal Teams, the CSC will hear reports and recommendations for initiatives based upon data from the Goal Teams and make recommendations to the EC for consideration and funding.
- Makes planning decisions and recommendations to the EC
- Supports strategic planning initiatives, accreditation, assessment, and program review for continuous improvement
- Identifies significant initiatives Ensures that data-driven decision making is implemented across the institution
- Provides in depth development of action plans for strategic goals of the College
- Promotes communication and representation across campus and among colleagues
- Conducts an annual review of the college goals for improvement and/or revisions
