## Affordability and Access Report

### November 1, 2018

The following report provides important and interesting data for the Grayson College Board of Trustees to know about the institution they govern. The information also fulfills the requirements of College policy AFA (Legal) and Education Code 51.4031. This data examines the affordability and access of the institution for the preceding fall, spring, and summer semesters.

### **Tuition and Fees**

***Grayson College's In-District tuition and fees are currently \$2,578, which is slightly lower than the community college state average of \$2,663 and the state average for medium-sized community colleges of \$2,685.*** This is based upon the average cost for a dependent student living off-campus enrolling in 15 hours in both fall and spring.

### **Gross Family Income of Grayson College Students**

***Thirty-five percent of our students receive some form of federal financial aid.***

There were 871 dependent students on financial aid and 1,123 independent students on aid. For those students, here is a distribution of students by their total family income as reported to the IRS. Additionally, this includes the student's "estimated family contribution," (EFC) or the amount of money that the Department of Education estimates that the student can contribute to their cost of attendance. This information is used in the calculation of student financial aid packages. Depending upon the number of hours a student enrolls, their EFC and cost of attendance will vary.

## **Admissions and Financial Aid Criteria**

Grayson College is an open door institution and admits students based on their achievement as a U.S. high school graduate, completion of a GED certificate, or as a transfer from another U.S. college. In addition to these admissions categories, GC welcomes eligible high school students who wish to enroll concurrently, and those who are admitted on Individual Approval. Once admitted to the college, some specialized workforce programs require additional entrance requirements. Below is further detail about the criteria used for admissions and financial aid awards:

- Show exceptional financial need
- Have a high school diploma or recognized equivalent such as a general Education Development (GED) Certificate, or has completed home schooling at the secondary level as defined by state law.
- Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment as a regular student working toward a degree or certificate in an eligible program (students may not receive aid for correspondence or telecommunications courses unless they are part of an associate's, bachelor's, or graduate degree program).
- Be a US citizen or eligible noncitizen
- Have a valid Social Security Number
- Make satisfactory academic progress
- Sign a statement on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) certifying that federal student aid will only be used for educational purposes
- Sign a statement on the FAFSA that the student is not in default on a federal student loan and that the student does not owe money back on a federal student grant.
- Register with the Selective Service, if required (if you are a male 18 through 25 and you have not yet registered with Selective Service, you can give Selective Service permission to register you by checking a box on the FAFSA, or register at [www.sss.gov](http://www.sss.gov)).

## **Profile of Students**

Attached is a profile of our students, on an annualized basis. ***Thirty-five percent of Grayson College students received some form of federal financial aid.*** Thirty-two percent of our students receive Pell grant and 37% receive loans. Seventy percent of our students are Caucasian, 11% Hispanic, and 7 % African-American. Sixty-nine percent of our students come from Grayson County, 14% from Fannin, 6% from Collin, and 4% from Oklahoma. This information reports unique students enrolled in one or more semesters from Fall 2017 to Summer II 2018. If a student enrolled in more than one semester, they are counted once.

## **College Cost Comparisons**

Grayson College continues to provide affordable higher education to our service area. The tuition and fees charged by Grayson College is below the state average, and ranked 30<sup>th</sup> (out of 50) among the 50 community colleges in the state for cost. The overall cost of attendance for Grayson is reported based upon estimated costs for room and board, travel, and other costs.

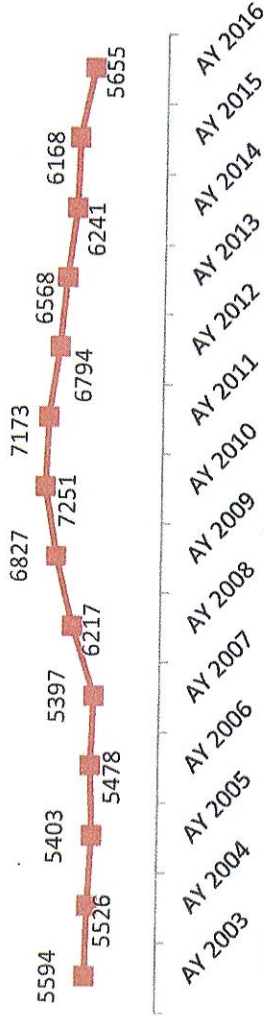
