Dual Credit Audio Engineering

SUMMARY

Grayson College's Small Business Certificate in Audio Engineering is designed to be your first step toward a career as an audio engineer, producer, recording artist, live sound technician, film/video game composer, songwriter, or sound designer. The courses in this certificate are intended to provide a foundational understanding of music theory, music technology, and the field of commercial music. In addition to the audio engineering courses this certificate includes business courses necessary to manage a small business.

CERTIFICATE

Students have two certificate options in the Audio Engineering program, the Occupational Skills Award and the Small Business Certificate in Audio Engineering. The Small Business Certificate consists of 30 credits, 15 of which are taken in Audio Engineering and Commercial Music, and 15 that are taken in Business and Finance. The Occupational Skills Award consists only of the 15 credits in Audio Engineering and Commercial Music. Each option may be completed in one year.

INSTRUCTOR

Classes are taught by Grayson College faculty.

CURRICULUM

Curriculum is created by Grayson College and consists of in-class lectures, demonstrations, hands-on projects, and remote assignments.

SCHEDULE

Classes are typically offered on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons.

FACILITY

Classes are held on the Grayson College main campus in Denison, TX in the Fine Arts Building Music Computer Lab. The course is generally capped at 8 due to software requirements.

TSI REQUIREMENT

None

PREREQUISITES

There are no prerequisites to enroll in the first semester of courses. Audio Engineering II requires successful completion of Audio Engineering I in order to enroll.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENT

State law requires that students under the age of 22 who will attend classes on a GC campus must provide documentation of a meningococcal vaccination within the

previous 5 years or a conscientious objection waiver. Students will not be enrolled without this documentation.
