## Dual Credit Cosmetology

### **SUMMARY**

Upon completion of the Grayson College Dual Credit Cosmetology Program, students will be prepared for the State of Texas Cosmetology licensure exam and entry-level employment in the field. They can also continue their education and complete the Cosmetology to Barber program after licensure.

### **CERTIFICATE**

Upon graduation students may earn specialization certificates in Cosmetology to Barber, Esthetics, and Nail Technology.

### **INSTRUCTOR**

Students will complete all course work at Grayson College in the afternoons. Sessions run Monday through Thursday each week.

### **CURRICULUM**

Curriculum is developed and provided by Grayson College and consists of materials located in the Canvas Learning Management System and hands-on lab activities.

### **SCHEDULE**

Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) requires the majority of Cosmetology hours to be obtained in a facilitated laboratory environment. Dual credit sections meet on the Grayson College Main Campus in Denison Monday through Thursday from 1:00 PM until 5:00 PM. Some online theory is allowed as a component of the hours required for the Cosmetology license.

### **FACILITY**

Classes are held in the Grayson College Career and Technology Center (CTS) on the Grayson College Main Campus in Denison.

### **TSI REQUIREMENT**

All Cosmetology Certificates meet the Texas Workforce Education Course Manual requirements for a "Level 1" Certificate. As such, all Cosmetology certificates are exempt from TSI requirements.

### **PREREQUISITES**

None.

### **VACCINATION REQUIREMENT**

State law requires that students under the age of 22 who will attend classes on a GC campus must provide documentation of a meningococcal vaccination within the previous 5 years or a conscientious objection waiver. Students will not be enrolled without this documentation.
