

SUMMARY

The Criminal Justice program is a 60 hour academic degree plan that prepares students to serve as a professional in sectors such as police, courts or corrections. An associates of science degree provides a foundation of criminal justice knowledge that will make the transition to the career field or four-year university seamless.

CERTIFICATE

Students can finish most of the transferable Field of Study in their Junior and Senior years online.

INSTRUCTOR

A credentialed professor from Grayson College.

CURRICULUM

Curriculum is provided by Grayson College and consists of materials located in the Canvas Learning Management System and hands-on lab activities.

SCHEDULE

Courses are offered 100% online for dual credit

FACILITY

Courses are offered online. If field projects are required in the course, the student is able to choose his/her own location to complete the field work.

TSI REQUIREMENT

Must be TSI complete.

PREREQUISITES

VACCINATION REQUIREMENT

State law requires that students under the age of 22 who will attend classes on a GC campus must provide documentation of a meningococcal vaccination within the previous 5 years or a conscientious objection waiver. Students will not be enrolled without this documentation.
