About

This form is required for verification of information filled out on FAFSA identified by Department of Education that may not match records.

Proof of Identity

In Person

The student must appear in person at Grayson College to verify his or her identity by presenting an unexpired valid government-issued photo identification (ID), such as, but not limited to, a driver's license, other state-issued ID, or passport. The institution will maintain a copy of the student's photo ID that is annotated with the date it was received and the name of the official at the institution authorized to collect the student's ID.

Not In Person

If the student is unable to appear in person at Grayson College to verify their identity, the student **must provide to the institution a copy of the unexpired valid government-issued photo identification (ID)** that is acknowledged in the notary statement below, or that is presented to a notary, such as, but not limited to, a driver's license, other state-issued ID, or passport.
