### **Core Requirements**

The Texas core requires 6 hours in Communication; 3 hours in Mathematics; 6 hours in Life and Physical Science; 3 hours in Creative Arts; 3 hours in Language, Philosophy, and Culture; 6 hours in History; 6 hours in Government; 3 hours in Social and Behavioral Science; and 6 hours of a Component Area Option.
